- (1) ICLO-NLS OPEN DAY

The opening of the Calendar year of ICLO-NLS activities and presentation of its Programme for 2013/14, will feature a screening and discussion of Ivan Ruiz's film "**Other Voices – A different outlook on Autism**" and an introduction of the new *Special Interest Group* "*Lacanian psychoanalytic practice with Children and Adolescents*". - (2) ICLO-NLS SEMINAR OF THE LACANIAN ORIENTATION WITH MEMBERS OF THE WAP – CLINICAL CONVERSATIONS

Guest psychoanalysts from abroad, members of the World Association of Psychoanalysis (WAP), join us four times a year to work on topics that are central to psychoanalytic clinical practice. The axis for this year is "**The Names of the Real in the 21st Century**", in consonance with the WAP Congress Paris 2014. This year's speakers are: *Patrick Monribot* (Bordeaux), *Veronique Voruz* (London), *Pierre-Gilles Guéguen* (Paris) and *Laure Naveau* (Paris).

The second part of these one-day Seminars, the *Clinical Conversations* are closed for ICLO members only.

- (3) ICLO-NLS – READING SEMINAR

This open Seminar of ICLO-NLS held under the title, "**Returning to Freud (II)**" is addressed to anybody with an interest in psychoanalytic thinking. Six seminars will provide the forum for a close reading and questioning of Freud's seminal clinical works, his case histories. An introduction to the conceptualisation of the 'case' in psychoanalysis will be followed by an in-depth reading of each of the five Freudian 'paradigms' for hysteria, obsessional neurosis, phobia and psychosis.

- (4) ICLO-NLS – OPEN SEMINAR

For the period 2013/14, and following the success of last year's events, this seminar will continue to explore the complex relationships between Lacanian theory and the world of the arts. This is a seminar open to all and it reflects ICLO's engagement with the wider intellectual and cultural community. Against any idea of 'applying psychoanalysis to the arts', this is an invitation to critically engage with questions such as creativity, sublimation, etc., following Lacan's indication that the artist precedes and teaches the analyst in his 'knowing-how to do with'.

- (5) ICLO-NLS SEMINAR OF THE SCHOOL

The Seminar of the School is an internal Seminar *for ICLO members*, whereby the dimension of Lacan's School is made present through the reading and discussion of a) the foundational texts referring to the concept of the School, the Cartel and the Pass; b) testimonies of the pass by Analysts of the School. The question of the formation of the analyst, the passage from analysand to analyst, the bond of the analyst to the School as subject, are some of the topics to be elaborated in this space.

- **(6) ICLO-NLS SPECIAL INTEREST GROUP**

The SIG **Child and Adolescent Lacanian Psychoanalysis** is a closed group that aims to work on specific areas related to the field of child analysis, in which participants are both engaged and wish to interrogate questions pertaining to their clinical work. A dialogue with other orientations / disciplines will be encouraged through visiting participants, and an annual special event partly open to the public will be organised.

- **(7) STUDY-DAY**

The ICLO-NLS Study-Day is the space where the year's cartel work and other work carried out by members and participants of ICLO is shared in a day of clinical and theoretical presentations, with the presence of a guest speaker from the NLS Executive Committee. In 2014 the topic of this Study-Day will be in line with that of the NLS Congress, Ghent 2014.

- **(8) ICLO-NLS CARTEL WORK**

Anyone with an interest in Lacanian Psychoanalysis may get involved in Cartel work. There are no requirements (i.e memberships, qualifications, clinical practice) *other than* wanting to inscribe one's singular relationship to psychoanalysis within the framework of this device invented by Lacan, where one works to find, interrogate and follow one's own trait in the reading of the texts.
